Intensive General English	(one week or more)

Courses can be started every Monday, except Public Holidays, until and including 13 December 2010. The TESOL programme and Fern English + Barista (Coffee) Package starts on the first Monday of every month except in December or on Public Holidays. TESOL and the Fern English + Barista (Coffee) Package start dates are as follows: 5 January / 1 February / 1 March / 6 April / 3 May / 8 June / 5 July / 2 August / 6 September / 4 October / 1 November.
